

Local entrepreneur awarded bronze in Asia Pacific Stevie Awards

Lisa Twyford, Managing Director of SA company Clear Decisions has been awarded the bronze award in the 2014 Asia Pacific Stevie awards in the category "Woman of the Year".

This is the second Stevie Award win for Lisa and the Clear Decisions team.

The Asia Pacific Stevie Awards are the first business awards program to recognise achievement in business in all 22 nations of the Asia-Pacific region. They are the newest of the Stevie Awards program, which are widely considered to be the world's premier business awards, conferring recognition for achievement in the workplace in programs such as the International Business Awards for more than a decade.

"We're delighted to be recognised internationally for our work amongst such outstanding entries," said Lisa Twyford, Founder and Managing Director Clear Decisions.

Gold, Silver and Bronze Stevie Award winners were selected by more than 50 executives around the world who participated in first-round judging the week of 14 April. A second international panel of judges will choose five Grand Stevie winners from among the Gold winners in early May.

Nicknamed the Stevies for the Greek word for "crowned", the awards will be presented to winners and Grand Stevie winners announced at a gala banquet at the Lotte Hotel in Seoul, South Korea on 30 May.

"Growing a small business in South Australia has been a fantastic adventure, and this nomination reflects just how much a dedicated and passionate team can make a difference," she said.
